

# The mystery of the number 9

Goethe also said: "Numbers don't rule the world, but they show how the world is governed."

Indeed, the world can be known through laws, proportions, and structures formed by numbers. Numbers are projections of geometric shapes. For example, 1 is a ray, 2 is an angle, 3 is a triangle, 4 is a square, 5 is a pentagram, etc. In other words, a number is an energy field that is represented as a certain shape (scheme, equation) and which, together with other numbers, creates a matrix system in intertemporal space - our world. This can be observed in nature: the spiral of a shell, the symmetry of a honeycomb, etc.

From here it is interesting to study the structure of the world from the point of view of numbers.

That's what we're going to do.

## Digit and number

A digit is a sign used to write a number. A number is an abstract entity used to describe quantity. A digit is a "letter", and a number is a "word" formed by a letter. A number is matter, and a number is consciousness. This is their difference and unity at the same time.

## Sacred numbers

There are a number of mathematical units that are considered sacred, namely these:

1. **the number pi:  $\pi=3.14$ ;**
2. **the square root of the number 2:  $\sqrt{2}=1.4$ ;**
3. **The square root of the number 3:  $\sqrt{3}=1.7$ ;**
4. **The square root of the number 5:  $\sqrt{5}=2.2$ ;**
5. **The number phi:  $\phi=1.6$ .**

According to mathematicians and philosophers, these numbers are sacred.

If you study the numbers from the series **0 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9**, here, too, you can find sacred numbers. Namely, these are odd numbers.: **1, 3, 5, 7, 9.**

- 1 - symbol of the beginning, God;
- 3 - the unity of the beginnings: past, present and future;
- 5 - the image of 5 human limbs (2 arms, 2 legs, head);
- 7- the symbol of life (7 days a week).

But the most interesting value is the number 9. We will study it.

## The sacred meaning of the number 9

9 is a number with many dimensions. A more correct interpretation of 9 is the representation of the beginning and end of a person's life path. It is an image of heaven, God, the cosmos, and the soul.

If you put the number 3 under a magnifying glass, you can see the number 9. This is an increased significance of the unity of the past, present and future.

There are 9 planets in our star system: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and... no, not Pluto. Pluto is a planetoid. The 9th planet is planet X, planet Nibiru. I believe that Nibiru is unlikely to ever be officially recognized as the 9th planet, since it is the

prototype of the number 9 in the range from 0 to 9. And as we found out, 9 is the number of the beginning and the end, a number that is outside the system. So there are 8 planets in our system+1. But not 9. 9 is the matrix of the Cosmos, it is the projection of the DNA program, it is the unification of the beginning and the end, it is something that is beyond our system. Let's see this with an example.

Let's schematically represent the numerological square of multiplying numbers from 1 to 9 by each other. Let's build a square: in the left column and the top row there are consecutive numbers from 1 to 9. Multiplying each number from the top row by each number from the left column and writing the result at the intersection, we get a square consisting of 81 cells. Let's write down in each cell the result of multiplying the numbers from the left column and the top row.

In the resulting square, we will reduce the two-digit numbers to single digits by adding the digits included in them. For example, consider the 2nd row.

Similarly, we calculate the remaining rows and get the next square.

There is a clear predominance of the number 9. It mystically encloses a square on both sides and is its logical end.

And if you alternately add a number to the number 9, the row will remain unchanged:

$$9 + 1 = 10; \quad \Sigma 10 = 1 + 0 = 1;$$

$$9 + 2 = 11; \quad \Sigma 11 = 1 + 1 = 2;$$

$$9 + 3 = 12; \quad \Sigma 12 = 1 + 2 = 3;$$

$$9 + 4 = 13; \quad \Sigma 13 = 1 + 3 = 4;$$

$$9 + 5 = 14; \quad \Sigma 14 = 1 + 4 = 5;$$

$$9 + 6 = 15; \quad \Sigma 15 = 1 + 5 = 6;$$

$$9 + 7 = 16; \quad \Sigma 16 = 1 + 6 = 7;$$

$$9 + 8 = 17; \quad \Sigma 17 = 1 + 7 = 8;$$

$$9 + 9 = 18; \quad \Sigma 18 = 1 + 8 = 9.$$

That is, 9 is outside the manifested energy of the universe. It goes beyond this system and is an unchanging number of consciousness.

As a result of our example, it became obvious that 9 multiplied by any other number always returns to itself; and if another number is added to 9, the result returns to this last number. It turns out that 9 controls other numbers.

The esoteric meaning of the number 9 lies in the synthesis of the three worlds: God, Heaven, Man. It contains the idea of completeness, harmony, and perfection, which symbolizes "everything" from beginning to end. The number 9 is a spiritual aspect in a material sense. The number 9 is prana among the series 0 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9, which is the basis for building the environment, nature, and the world. The number 9 is consciousness, while the rest of the decimal numbers are matter.

The number 9 is a symbol of the origin of life, because it resembles the shape of a sperm cell. The number 9 is a symbol of completeness. Indeed, a circle is a figure reflecting the image of completeness and completeness. And in the circle  $360^\circ$ .  $3 + 6 + 0 = 9$ . Again, 9.
